“Stress Mechanisms in Major Depression: From Exposure
to Response”

Dr. Kate Harkness is a Professor in the Psychology and Psychiatry Departments at Queen's University. Dr. Harkness received her PhD from the University of Oregon, and completed her internship and post doctoral fellowship at Western Psychiatric Institute and Clinic in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Her work focuses on understanding the causes of early onset depression, and she is currently heading a federally funded study investigating gene environment interactions in the first episode of depression in adolescents and young adults.
